The Toshiba/NSTA ExploraVision STEM competition promotes project-based learning that aligns with Next Generation Science Standards, and it's FREE to enter!

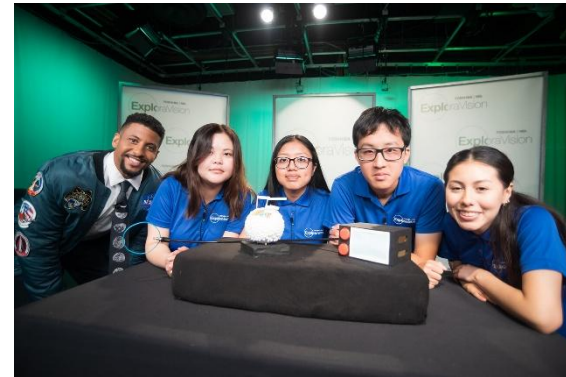
- **What you have to do:**

- ✓ Communication skills

- **Entry Deadline:** January 27, 2027



- **Eligibility:** All full-time K-12 students in the US and Canada that have a coach.

- **Prizes:** All students receive an entry prize for participating. Each regional winner including their coach receives a gift, and National winning students receive educational savings bonds of \$5K* or \$10K* each and a trip to Washington, D.C.
