Please ensure that teams “check off” each item below before submitting to help ensure a qualified project. We encourage you to ask someone who has not been involved with the project to review for compliance.

- ☐ Does the team consist of two, three or four student members and a coach? The mentor is optional.
- ☐ The student, coach, mentor or school names do **not** appear in the Abstract, Description, Bibliography or on the Technology Launch Flyer.
- ☐ Is the title 50 characters maximum?
- ☐ Is the [abstract](#):
 - 150 words maximum
 - not part of the Description
- ☐ Do you have each of the following in your [Description](#) in the same order as below?
 - Project Title at the top of the page (50 characters maximum)
 - Present Technology
 - History
 - Future Technology
 - Breakthroughs
 - Design Process
 - Consequences (Both positive and negative)
- ☐ Is the Description 11 pages or less?
- ☐ Do you have a [Bibliography](#) (not counted as part of the 11- page Description)?
- ☐ Did you submit the **one-page** Technology Launch Flyer (not part of the description)?



- ☐ Does the Technology Launch Flyer have an image of your future technology (the image cannot be generated/drawn by AI).
- ☐ Is your Project submitted in English?
- ☐ Is your Description:
 - typed and double spaced?
 - 1" margins?
 - font a standard 12-point size or larger, but no larger than 18-point size?
- ☐ Is this submitted by 8:00 pm ET on January 27, 2027 (see our home page for any updates)?
